A goal of the SPIRIT Program is to enable volunteers to participate with as little disruptions to their schedules as possible. The SPIRIT staff coordinate care between the patient's referring clinic, patient and volunteer physician. SPIRIT volunteers provide one-time consultations and evaluations at their private practices or, at the Sacramento County Health Center or community clinic with the patient's PCP assuming responsibility for implementing the follow up care plan as recommended by the volunteer physician.

The care donated by SPIRIT volunteers positively impacts the health of SPIRIT patients. As one SPIRIT patient shared: "I had not been to a doctor since I was 18. Words cannot express how thankful I am for all of this wonderful care."
