SPIRIT is a collaboration between SSVMS and Dignity Health, Kaiser Permanente, Sutter Health, the UC Davis Health System, and the County of Sacramento. Working together with partner physicians that donate their time and medical services, we provide uninsured people in the Sacramento region the care that helps them lead healthier, more productive lives.

There is a waiting list of patients who are only able to access specialty consults through SPIRIT. We are seeking physicians who can volunteer care and treat patients in their private practices, or in county or community clinics, particularly for the following high-demand specialties.

- General Surgery

SPIRIT coordinates all case management and care coordination between the referring clinic, patient and volunteer.

SPIRIT services are limited to either one-time consultation and evaluation, or one-time only outpatient surgical care.
