FUTURE OF MEDICINE VOLUNTEER PATHWAYS

Museum of Medical History: Volunteers serve as docents and lead school classes on museum tours that highlight the history of medicine in the Sacramento region.

High-School Volunteer: SSVMS partners with volunteer physicians and Sacramento region high schools in an endeavor to educate youth on health-related issues, empower them to make healthy lifestyle choices and interest students in pursuing a career in medicine. Volunteer opportunities in high schools range from serving as a one-time guest speaker to acting as a classroom mentor. SSVMS coordinates the placement of volunteers, provides access to health-related teaching aids and mentoring guides.

Medical Student Mentor: Physicians volunteer to provide guidance to medical students as they pursue a future in medicine. Opportunities to mentor include meeting with students at SSVMS sponsored Mentor Events and, providing supervision and guidance on student-led, research projects.
