SSVMS' COVID-19 vaccine clinic for private practice physicians and staff launched over the weekend. Appointments are available starting tomorrow, January 12. We have arranged for Sacramento County to provide the vaccines for this purpose to UC Davis. SSVMS is managing the logistics (physician recruitment, gathering demographics, verifying eligibility) and UCD will host the clinic on site at the medical center.

Appointments are required and are by invitation only. To enroll in the clinic, we request that a point of contact be identified at each physician practice and /or clinic by completing [SSVMS' brief survey](#). After SSVMS staff verifies the information, the practice will receive a link where they will be able to upload required demographics for each physician and practice employee. Only practices that are located in Sacramento County and that enroll through SSVMS will be eligible to receive the vaccine through this program.

Yolo County is vaccinating community physicians and office staff this week on Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday. Again, physicians can register through [SSVMS' brief survey](#). SSVMS will arrange for Yolo County Public Health to email eligible physicians a unique link through which they can schedule an appointment.

Placer County is currently vaccinating independent physicians and office staff. Physicians can register through the [SSVMS survey](#). SSVMS will arrange for Placer County Public Health to email eligible physicians a secure link through which they can schedule an appointment.
